Dear Parents and Carers,

I am pleased to inform you that we been given the opportunity to visit Sandfield Farm in Sedgeberrow on Wednesday 21st November.

We will be shown around the farm by Emma Harrison, who has numerous schools visiting the farm each year and runs workshops tailored to each school's topic. She has created an exciting programme of events which will be tailored around our own 'Invaders and Settlers' topic. This will be an excellent opportunity to take our learning outside of the classroom and to compare Anglo Saxon / Viking farming to modern day farming.

The farm has been set up with appropriate facilities for school visits and there are lots of opportunities for exciting cross curricular activities.

The trip will be run within the school day. Children need to wear suitable clothing for going out on a farm (they may get muddy!) They should have warm, waterproof coats, waterproof trousers if possible, hats and wellies. They should also have a spare set of clothes in a bag. A packed lunch and drink will also be required, as we will be on the farm all day and no other food will be available.

The cost of this trip will be £6.50 per pupil. We request a voluntary contribution of this amount and although your child would not be denied the opportunity to take part if you were unable to make this contribution, we may not be able to proceed unless there are sufficient contributions to cover the cost of the trip. As ever, we ask for all payments to be made via ParentPay where you will automatically give your consent for your child to take part in the trip.

We will also need a sufficient number of volunteers, so please let Mr Bridges or the Office know if you are able to help on the day.
